Rules

1. Schedule

Sunday May 17, 2026, between 9:30 and 19:30.

2. General Regulations

The laws of chess will be applied in their annex A (Rapid Chess).

It will be applied. Art.4 Rapid chess in all Tournament.

There will be obligatory Rules for all players.

All players can participate with current Official license. It will be necessary to have Fide Code.

3. Playing venue

Hostal Cal Batista: Carrer del Raval, s/n, 08695 –Bagà-. **LIMITED PLACES**

4. Rounds

9 rounds in the Swiss System, pairings will be done with the Swiss Manager program.

- **Morning: 5 rounds (start 09:30 hours)**

Round 1 09:30 Round 2 10:25 Round 3 11:20 Round 4 12:15 Round 5 13:10

- **Afternoon: 4 rounds (start 16:00 hours)**

Round 6 16:00 Round 7 16:55 Round 8 18:50 Round 9 18:45

The first round will begin at 9h30 pm. The reception and payment of unpaid inscriptions will begin at 8h45.

5. Time control

15 minutes + 5 seconds per move (15' + 5").

6. Groups and Evaluation

Single Group. Valid to FIDE and Catalan rapid rating system.

7. Ranking

The ranking will be done by FIDE rapid rating.

If any player don't have it, the standard FIDE rating will be used from his Catalan rapid ELO. If a player you don't have anyone, National rating will be used.

8. Tournament Category into Catalan Circuit

Tournament "b" in the 22th Catalan Circuit of International Chess Opens 2026.

9. Awards delivery

The closing awards ceremony it will be the same day, after the last round, approximately at 20:00. It will be mandatory attendance of all players who must collect an award **be provided by DNI, NIE or Passport** (or delegated person with signed authorization and photocopy of the corresponding accreditation document).

In the case of minors under age, the prize must be paid by legal representative.

Otherwise, if the Prize is not recognized, this remains abandoned.

NOTE: All the cash Prizes will be paid deducing legal taxes.

10. Registration

Until May 16 at 20:00h.

The form you will find on the CE Lillet or Cal Batista websites must be filled:

Between 24 and 48h of filling the form, the name will be added to the list of registration on the same website. This registration will not be definitive until the corresponding payment has been made.

Registrations fees will be:

- General: 25€
- Sub-16: 20€
- +60 years 20€
- disabled persons (recognized as such by FCdE) 20€
- Members of the Lillet Chess Club 15€

Those invited by the organisation will be exempt from registration payments.

It will not be possible to participate without having made the corresponding payment before the first round.

11. Timeout

The time to stand in front of the board will be the flag's drop. Players who non-appear one round will be eliminated.

12. Restrictions to game premises and complementary services

Smoking is banned throughout the enclosure. At the same time, every person at the playground, whether participating or not, is banned from having the cell phone turned on while there is an unfinished game. Otherwise, the sanction will be decided by the arbitration team.

In the local has bar service.

Registrations will be counted in order of arrival. Until the payment has been made, it will not be considered firm.

13. Committee

There will be no competition committee. In order not to hinder the proper functioning of the tournament, referral decisions will be in appointable during its development. In the game room there will be an official print of claims available where the corresponding written claim can be made to the corresponding organs of the Catalan Chess Federation.

14. Tie-breaks

The tie-breaks in the final classification will be resolved as follows:

- The particular result (DE)
- Average performances of the opponents' tournament (APRO)
- Average Bucholz of opponents (AOB)
- Tournament performance (TPR)
- Bucholz total -2 (BT-C2)

15. Tournament direction

APPENDIX

COMPULSORY RULES FOR ALL PARTICIPATING PLAYERS

DELIVERY RESULTS

The winning player of the game will have to make sure on writing the scoresheet and hand over it to the arbiter table.

The loser player will take charge of putting the pieces to the initial position.

In case the game ends in draw, Black player will deliver the scoresheet and the White player will take charge of putting the pieces to the initial one.

The players will be the last and only responsible for any writing of results according to incorrect filling in the result sheet.

Once the round is over and after 5 minutes, if some result is missing because it has not been delivered, the result of the game will be 0-0.

No claim to wrong results will be accepted after the next round is over.

No complaints about results will be accepted after last round of the Tourney begins.

GAME START

Games will start strictly at the stipulated hours at the tournament's Bases, if there are no delays or unexpected incidents, all players are recommended to be present in front of the board at the stipulated time, so the clock will be set to start at the noted hour.

Awards: After last round

CLOCKS

The clock can only be stopped to request the presence of an arbiter.

According to Article 6.11.4. of the Laws of Chess, if a player stops the clock without justified cause according to the arbiter, it can be sanctioned under Article 12.9

REQUEST OF ARBITER PRESENCE

If a player requires the presence of a arbiter, it will act as follows:

1. He will stop the clocks and raise his hand to request the assistance of the arbiter.
2. In case anyo arbiter is currently available in the area, he will ask the arbiter's table for assistance of one of them.

These rules are unalterable and participation in the Tournament means its unqualified acceptance.
